Archangelskoe

“Archangelskoe” is one of Krauze Studio’s most poetic and refined residential projects, located near a historic estate outside Moscow. The design reimagines a classic countryside villa with a modern sensibility, emphasizing peace, harmony, and connection to nature.

The home sits within a gently wooded landscape, and the architecture responds to this setting with natural materials, soft lines, and large windows that frame views of the surrounding forest. Inside, the spaces unfold gradually, revealing subtle transitions between public and private, open and intimate.

Krauze Studio approached the project with a narrative mindset, drawing inspiration from Russian classical architecture, but translating it through a contemporary lens. The result is a home that feels rooted in place yet timeless, serene yet expressive.

Interior elements include custom furniture, warm plaster walls, muted stone, and handcrafted details. The palette is soft and organic, echoing the tones of the outdoors. Light plays a central role, with skylights and carefully placed openings enhancing the sense of calm.
